History

Jeanne Delp was a remarkable educator who made a difference in the lives of children and adults throughout her long career. Jeanne was instrumental in statewide efforts to make parents truly equal partners in the education of gifted and talented young learners.

Purpose

These grants will facilitate a project designed to promote the active involvement or education of the parents of a classroom of gifted youngsters. The objective of the grant is to provide funding for a project that would otherwise not be possible as the teacher works to include parents to help secure the success of the GATE students.

Amount of Grant

\$250

Eligibility

Educators who apply for the grant must be GATE certified.

Application Requirements

In addition to the application form below, you must submit:

1. A one-page description of the nature and purpose of the proposal stating how it will promote the active involvement of parents in the education of gifted students.
2. A list of clear goals.
3. Budget statement showing proposed expenses.
4. Timeline of implementation of the proposal.

Selection Process

The CFGE Scholarship Committee will evaluate your application considering equally your proposal and timeline. Announcement will be made in November, 2016.
